What is the DBA?

The Downtown Bloomington Association (DBA) is a not-for-profit, membership based organization that supports business and property owners, as well as residents with their efforts to enhance the vitality and livability of Downtown Bloomington.

"The Downtown Bloomington Association offers stewardship for the great assets that are found in the 26 blocks that together comprise our downtown community. Why is Downtown Important?

Downtown is our community's most visible indicator of its heritage, pride and economic vitality. A vibrant downtown can be an asset in recruiting new residents, new businesses and industries, retirees, tourists and others to our community.

Since 2005, Downtown Bloomington has been a designated member of the Main Street Program. This program was developed by the National Trust for historic Preservation to help revitalize traditional downtowns and neighborhood commercial centers. Illinois Main Street Serves 42 communities here in our home state.

Does Main Street Work?

A Main Street program is a grassroots, volunteer-driven non-profit business. It is based on the belief that successful downtown revitalization takes into account all aspects of downtown. This is called the Four Point Approach. Our committees are mobilized through committees that reflect those four points. Here's what they do:

- 1. **Design** Enhances downtown's physical environment so it is an attractive place to live, work and visit. Ongoing projects include Adopt a Pot, Tree well gardens, and Public Art/Murals.
- 2. **Promotion** Showcases Downtown through events that leverage the unique history, culture, architecture and businesses to attract visitors, customers and residents. Ongoing events include Farmers' Markets, First Fridays, Downtown Trivia Night, Route 66 Cruise In, and Tour de Metro.
- 3. **Economic Restructuring** Attracts new entrepreneurs and helps existing businesses grow by responding to present and future economic opportunities. Ongoing community partnerships SCORE, EDC, City of Bloomington, ISU Stevenson Center
- 4. **Organization** Engages and educates the community on the importance of downtown. Focuses on increasing membership and fundraising.

Our Mission and Vision

The mission of the Downtown Bloomington Association is to promote the revitalization and growth of Historic Downtown Bloomington through collaboration among property owners, private Citizens, community and business leaders, town and government representatives and civic organizations.

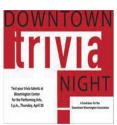
Sponsorship Opportunities
